This committee wants to educate both consumers and restaurant operators of the need to reduce the use of plastic straws, or the use of any type of straw entirely. Committee members scouted out how local businesses in our area handled straws. Do they use only plastic straws (most do); do they automatically pass out these straws without patron request (some do, some have them available at a counter or table for customers' optional use). Committee plans to organize information to pass out to restaurant operators and maybe individual customers on the importance of environmentally friendly ways to drink liquids.
